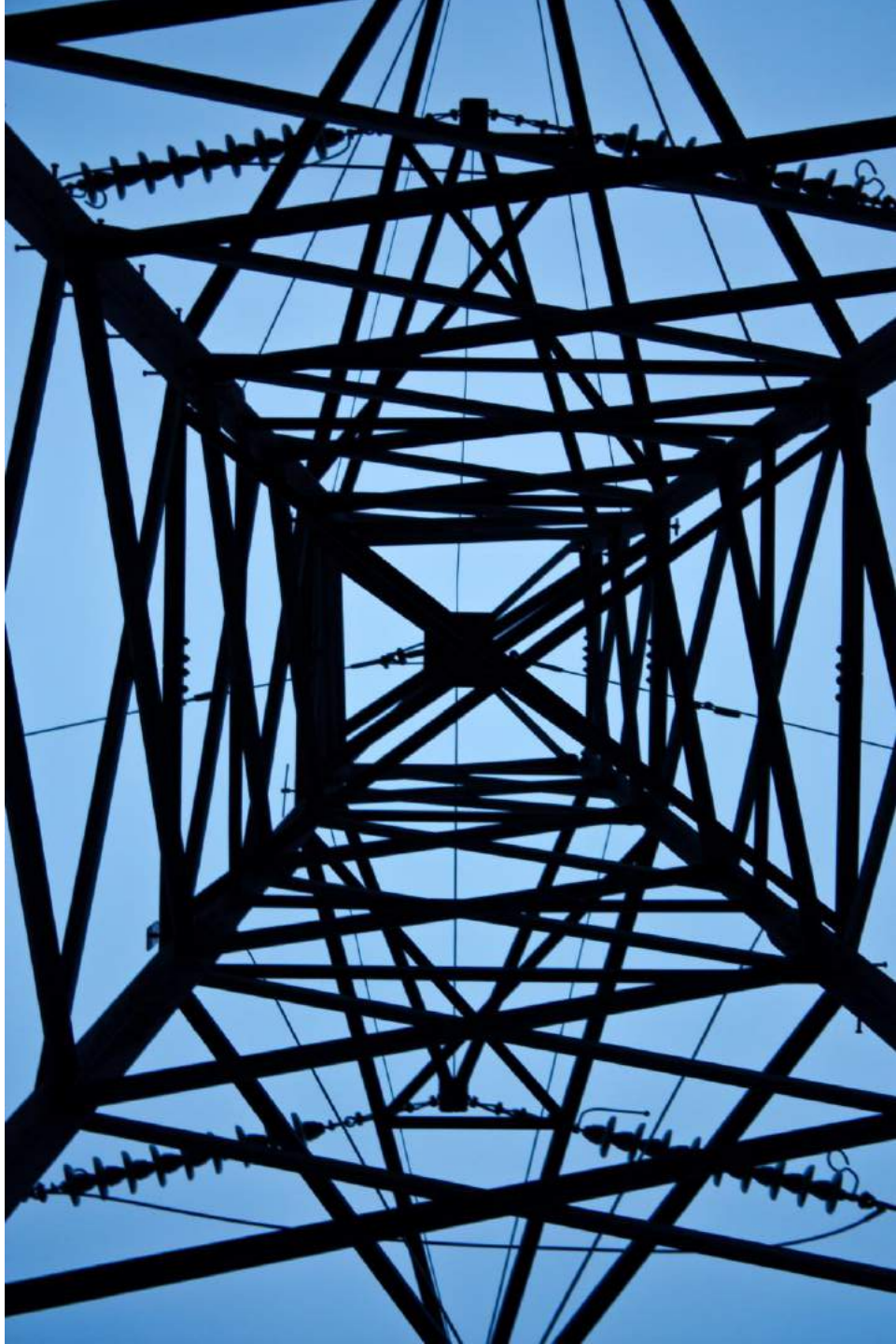
# CONTEXT

The project is designed as a seminar on inclusion of IDPs and refugees in the hosting communities is to empower youth and NGO workers with tools and practices in their work on inclusion and humanitarian support of IDPs and refugees.

The seminar "Exchange of Good Practices and Learning from Experiences - EDPLEX" will involve 31 youth workers and representatives of NGOs from 9 program countries (France, Spain, Lithuania, Poland Portugal, Slovenia, Sweden, Italy and Turkey).

# The STRUCTURE

During the 9 days, participants will be active in seminar which will consist of the following phases: getting-to-know each other and integration activities, setting common ground (presentation of the program, aims and objectives of the seminar, presentation of Erasmusplus introduction to Youth Pass, presentations of organizations of participants, theoretical phase definition of IDPs and refugees, sharing the practices of national and local legislations on IDPs and refugees, practical phase on the needs and challenges of IDPs and refugees and local communities, planning of follow-up and evaluation.

Seminar will happen in an international environment using non-formal methods.

Reflections will happen in a group context and also individually.

Simulations will take place to understand common questions and behaviors related to the topic

Discussions will take place in small and big groups over the topic and related areas.

# Roles and Responsibilities

- ✓ To fill in the application form.
- ✓ If you are selected then; to search and inform us about the details of the tickets and buy them **AFTER GETTING CONFIRMATION** from the coordinator.
- ✓ To keep all documents related to travel.
- ✓ To prepare for the activities, do local activities and disseminate (share ) the project result with other people.
- ✓ To attend in the all sessions of the project activity
- ✓ Prepare short country presentation and as well bring snacks and drinks for intercultural night activity of the seminar.
- ✓ Make a research and prepare short presentations about the situation of IDPs in their communities, within the collaboration of participants from the same country.

# PARTNER ORGANIZATIONS SHOULD

- Find motivated and proactive participants
- Ensure gender balance, 1 or 2 participants with fewer opportunities.
- Assist travel arrangements.
- Support participation during preparation, dissemination phase
- Disseminate projects outcomes.
- Have effective communication with the coordinator of the project.
- Ensure the visibility of the project in their local and region.





# FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

◆ 100% accommodation, food and program materials are covered by the grant from Erasmus+

◆ 100% traveling costs (only most economical) are covered, up to the maximum expenses:

Lithuania	€275 per person – 3 Participants
Poland	€275 per person – 4 Participants
Portugal	€275 per person – 3 Participants
Slovenia	€275 per person – 3 Participants
Spain	€275 per person – 3 Participants
Sweden	€275 per person – 3 Participants
Turkey	€360 per person – 4 Participants

# HEALTH INSURANCE

**Private Health insurance is Mandatory** for ALL participants and should be presented upon the arrival.

The following areas must be covered:

- travel insurance (including damage or loss of luggage);
- third party liability (including, wherever appropriate, professional indemnity or insurance for responsibility);
- accident and serious illness (including permanent or temporary incapacity);
- death (including repatriation in case of projects carried out abroad).

If applicable, **it is strongly recommended that participants in transnational activities are in possession as well of a European Health Insurance Card.** This is a free card that gives access to medically necessary, state-provided healthcare during a temporary stay in any of the 28 EU countries under the same conditions and at the same cost (free in some countries) as people insured in that country.
